SideShift is a crypto exchange. My responsibility was improving client side architecture and performance. Also implementing **end-to-end tests** from scratch. Our stack was **React** with **Typescript**, **GraphQL** and **nodejs** on server side. Also worked on some **CI** task improvements and touched **backend** code too.

Coinweb.io, Remote – May 2020 - Jul. 2021

I worked mostly with **React** on our **blockchain wallet** but also wrote some **React Native** and **nodejs** code as well.

Docler Holding, Budapest – Oct. 2019 - May 2020

At Docler I worked on a **desktop application's** frontend. The app was written in C++ and QT, with an embedded browser view. We used **React** for UI and **Redux-Saga** to manage state handling of the application.

Ingatlan.com is Hungary's biggest real estate site. Our team worked on the main site. We maintained a **huge legacy codebase** and turned it into a component based **responsive UI** using **Vue** framework. I worked on client side of our main project, Easyling. The app is a widely used online proxy translation tool. Our app and its components were written in **Angular 1**, later we started to migrate it to **Angular 2** using **Dart** instead of Typescript.
